- > **Cleveland Clinic London** is the newest location in Cleveland Clinic's expanding **global healthcare system**. Our London facilities allow us to extend our model of care to more patients than ever.
- > Cleveland Clinic is a United States-based nonprofit multispecialty academic medical centre that integrates clinical and hospital care with research and education. It is recognised as **one of the world's best healthcare providers**.
- > Cleveland Clinic London consists of a **hospital** and an **outpatient centre**.
- > **Cleveland Clinic London Hospital** is located at 33 Grosvenor Place, near Buckingham Palace, in central London. The historic building has been converted into an eight-storey, 325,000-square-foot **state-of-the-art medical centre** with 184 patient beds. It provides comprehensive inpatient medical and surgical services with a special focus on cardiovascular, digestive, neurological and orthopaedic care.
- > GP and consultant clinics are located at **Cleveland Clinic Portland Place Outpatient Centre**, a six-storey, 28,000-square-foot building at 24 Portland Place, in the Harley Street Medical Area.

RESEARCH AND EDUCATION

- > Collaborating with the U.K. health and life sciences sector to **share knowledge and improve patient care**.
- > Working closely with Cleveland Clinic's U.S. hospitals and the Lerner Research Institute**, which are at the **forefront of clinical care and research**.
- > Seeking to establish a medical research data repository — the first U.K. private healthcare organisation to do so in its own name. Cleveland Clinic London BioResource will allow **collection, storage and analysis of consented patient data** to improve healthcare.
- > Developing a unique collaborative fellowship programme to **train the next generation of neurologists and neurosurgeons**. The clinical component is based at Cleveland Clinic London; MD/PhD research is supervised by the University College London Queen Square Institute of Neurology.
- > Partnering with academic schools of nursing to provide **professional development and long-term student placements**.

** Cleveland Clinic's Lerner Research Institute is one the largest research institutes in the U.S. It consistently ranks in the top 10 in funding from the National Institutes of Health, a benchmark of research prowess.

TECHNOLOGY

- > Using leading-edge methods to enhance the **safe administration of medications**, such as a pharmacy robot that individually wraps and tracks drugs by bar code to the patient's bedside.
- > Employing **advanced electronic medical record technology** such as caregiver devices and patient apps to help patients actively participate in their care.
- > Offering **intraoperative imaging** for patients undergoing brain and spinal cord surgeries, reducing the need for repeat operations.
- > Providing **transcatheter aortic valve implantation (TAVI)**, a minimally invasive nonsurgical procedure to replace a narrowed aortic valve in a patient's heart.
