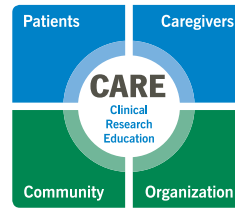

- » No. 2 U.S. hospital in 2021-22 “Best Hospitals” rankings

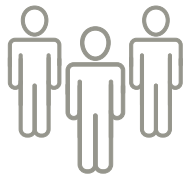
